4. Applicants are entitled to only ONE (1) scholarship/ waiver/ reward at any one time (unless stated otherwise). The one with the highest quantum will automatically apply.
5. The scholarships, waivers and rewards awarded are not exchangeable for cash or any other alternatives.
6. The scholarships, waivers and rewards awarded exclude other fees and charges such as application, registration, admission, resource, assessment and franchise fees to partner universities (where applicable), all of which must be borne by the successful applicants.
7. Scholarships offered are valid only for the original duration of the programme offered and strictly cannot be transferred to any other programmes at UM-Wales.
8. Students of the UM-Wales High Achiever Scholarship, STPM/A-Levels Scholarship, Government Matriculation Scholarship, UEC Scholarship must maintain a minimum CGPA yearly to obtain the scholarship for the following year and serve a minimum number of hours to the university:
100% Scholarship: CGPA of 3.5 and 100 hours
75% Scholarship: CGPA of 3.3 and 85 hours
50% Scholarship: CGPA of 3.0 and 70 hours
*Foundation students do not need to meet the CGPA requirements
9. Students must meet the minimum CGPA requirements at the end of each academic year. If students fail to meet the requirements, the scholarship will be reviewed.
10. Work hours should be served during their scholarship tenure while studying, which includes working with different departments within UM-Wales for enhanced exposure, acting as an Ambassador of UM-Wales at various events, attending leadership development programmes, etc., to continue their scholarship in subsequent year(s).
11. Where applicable, scholarship recipients will be required to sign an agreement accepting the terms and conditions of the scholarship after enrolling into the programme.
12. All scholarships and bursaries are applicable for studies at UM-Wales in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia only and are not applicable for the period of study at overseas partner universities (where applicable).
13. UM-Wales reserves the right to reject incomplete or late application forms.
14. Students must complete the programme to be entitled for the scholarship and bursaries offered.
15. All scholarships are deducted from the tuition fees.
16. All scholarships are subject to availability in addition to the student meeting the minimum criteria stated.
17. Scholarships for immediate family members refers to parents, siblings, spouse and children.
18. Scholarship recipients who fail to comply with all the terms and conditions of the scholarship will be required to pay back 100% of the total scholarship amount disbursed to him/ her by UM-Wales.
